It's About Me!

Problem:

Write a C++ program that will output information about you to the computer screen. The output should look like this:

Name: <your name>

Major: <your major, spelled out please>

Favorite Book or Movie: <put title in quotes. Book author optional>

Replace the stuff in the angle brackets with your own information. Here's an example:

Name: Jill Seaman

Major: Computer Science

Favorite Book or Movie: "The Gods Must Be Crazy"

It's ok if the title is long and it wraps onto the next line.
There must be a blank line between each item.

Logistics:

Include the following header at the top of the source code file (add your name, date and assignment number)

Name your file **assign1_xxxxxxxx.cpp** where xxxxxxxxx is your 9 character TX state ID number, the one that is on your ID card. It should look something like this: A04123456. If yours is just six digits, then add "A00" to the front.
